Thank you very much for the outline, Alfred. We look forward to receiving a draft when it is available.

My first impression is very positive. I would only venture two comments:
1) Since we will have a section on Russian backgrounds I would suggest keeping that quite brief.

2) I know it will be difficult to keep it to a manageable length, but would appreciate efforts to keep it from getting too long. At the same time, we will have to evaluate the lengths when we get all the material and it is easier for us as editors to shorten the manuscript than to add to it. We hope the writers will understand that.

Our Historical Commission is meeting next week and we will inform you regarding any other issues.
