- son of Hazarat Syed Server Bayabani, grandson of Syed Gulam Abdul Biyabani. Born 1794 A.D., did 12 years penance in a cave in his early years, died in 1857.
- great great grand father came to Kazipet from Ambur in Aurangabad Dist. The governor or kazir of Warangal gave him three villages as a jagir.
- when the military headquarters were moved the Hyderabad, sepoy's went to find Mallas and Madigas for labor. These had fled. The sepoy's found Afzal and thought him to be an untouchable, so they made him carry a heavy load which he did with ease, and fast. They saw his legs float on air, so they worshipped him.
- had a daughter who was the mother of the Nizam's foreign minister

Hazarat Syed Shah Jalaluddin (Jamalul Bahar Mashuk-e-Rabbani Rahmatullah)
Warangal FF 12; 1601

- born Bagdad, Hijra 901. Came to Turnkala Somaram near Warangul in 955 H and lived there 22 years. Settled there in an Urs after doing penance on a hill. King gave him a horse which his disciples ate. This made the king angry so the Syed brought the horse back to life. He lived to be 99 years old and became a saint.

Hussain Vali

??
Proddatur, Cuddapah; 306; 605; 1507; 307; 1003

- a resident of Neamlladinne of Koikuntala Tq, Kurnool Dt. The five wives of Sri Poli Subbi Reddy, a rich landlord, died delivering sons. On a suggestion, he went with friends to Nemalladinne and prostrated himself before Hussainaiah. Though the saint kicked him many times, he would let go of his feat. The saint took pity on him, embraced him and advised him to marry two women simultaneously and he would lead a peaceful married life. So he did so in the saint's presence. After that Subba Reddy lost no wives. In gratitude he built a mantapam and personally served the saint there.

Hyder Vali

208 *Cuddapah 6*

- 65 years ago Hyder Vali lived by farming in Kondur. One day while bailing out the water from the well into the field, he felt a peculiar quivering, and with an awe-inspiring expression on his

face jumped into the well, shouting **dhin**. His brother jumped in to save him but could not find him. Later he was seen sitting on the water in a padmasana pose. When his brother persuaded him to come out, he jumped to the edge of the well in one leap and went to the darga shouting **dhin**. He was installed in the darga. He became a saint who attained jeeva samadhi in Kocheruvuv, Anantapur Dt. This experience led him to spirituality and to settle down here. He did many miracles. He got inspired when he wore a garland made of silver coins containing Urdu script, and the mud and sticks he gave to others turned into sugar and incense sticks. For a while each Thursday there was a procession. Now it is annually.

Mastha Vali (also known as Kabeshah and Mastanaiah) (see Hyder Saheb)
Mahbubnagar 136; 206; 209; Kasumur, Nellore Dist.; Anantapur pp. 71,84
Cuddapah;
- Urs of 20,000 at Kasumur. People come for physical healing and exorcism of evil spirits by worshipping at the tomb and using sandalwood or sandlewood paste collected from the shrine on the day of the Urs.
- came to Guntakel 150 years ago. Sat near Chinna Darga in bad health, so the village elders drove him away. After that there was a heavy rainfall, and they felt sorry for him so they went to find him. They were astonished to find him in different ugly forms, and no rain had fallen on the spot where he sat. When the leader approached him, he asked for jeeva samadhi (to be buried alive) s they complied.
- born in Cuddapah district
- at 65 came to Macherla, Mahabubnagar Dst. Short, lean, almost naked begger bowl and had a hollow bangle on his right arm which had miraculous pwer. Loved toddy, arrak and ganja. Begged. If some told him they had nothing, the saint told them exactly how much they had in their pockets, so they gave. Drank continually, slept little, maintained a strong mental and physical condition. Healed children's diseases. Renounced the world and gave up food.
