GENERAL HINDU MALE DEITIES

Dattatreya: Dattaguru

Anantapur p. 103-4

- Hindu triad: Brahma, Vishnu and Siva
- Anasuya was famous for her chastity (patirrathyam) so Saraswati, Lakshmi and Parvati were jealous and tried to discredit her. They forced their husband, the triad, to go as rishis and beg her for food. When she was about to serve them, they demanded she do so inside. Her power of chastity was so great she turned them into babies and gave them food. Narada Rishi teased the wives because they now had to live apart from their husbands forever unless they asked Anasuya to restore them. She did and prayed for their progeny. They granted her Dattatreya - 3 headed. Husband was Athrimuni.
