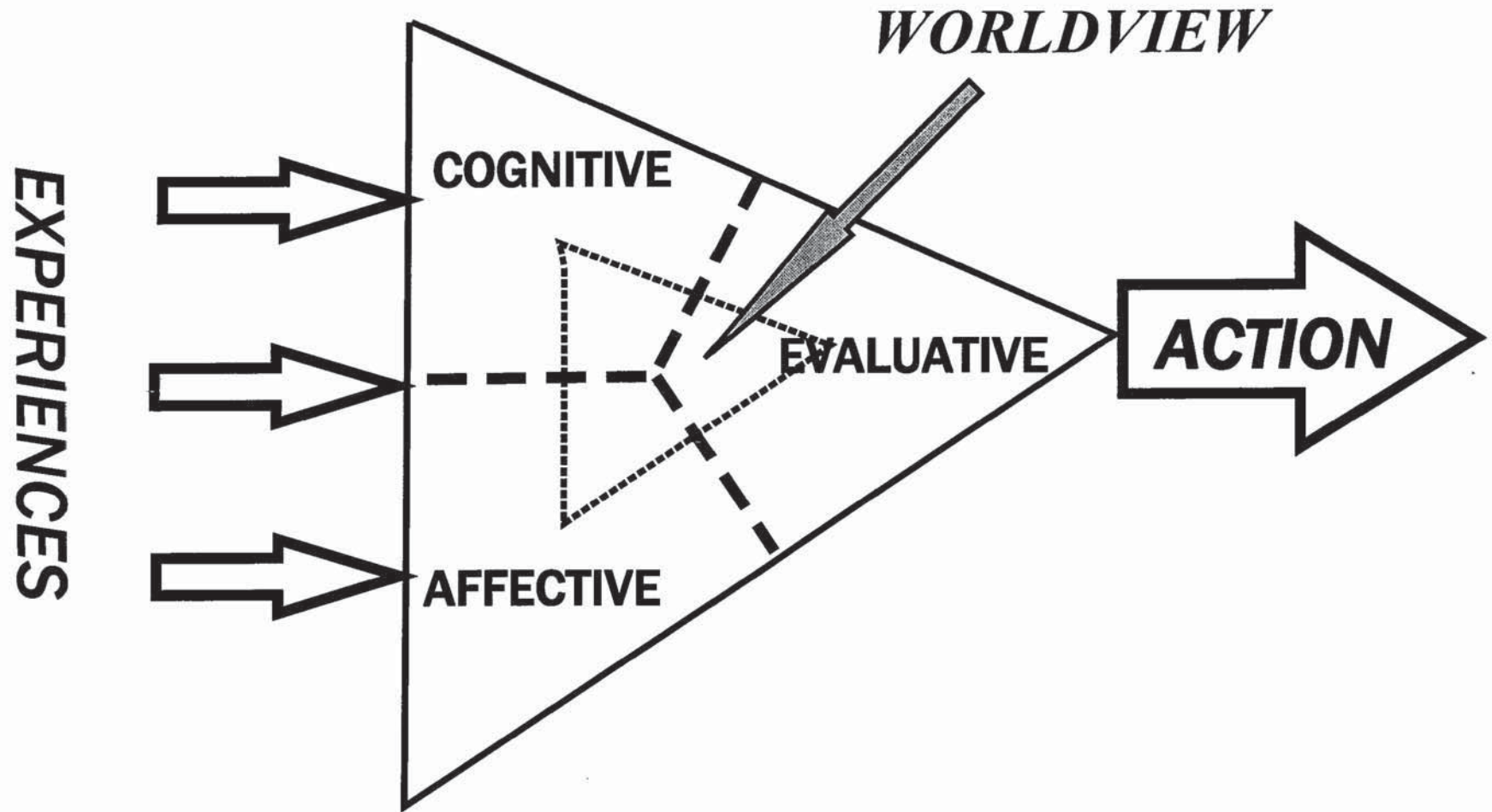

Primary Emphasis: [point of departure]	Doctrine and den- ational tradition	Community and extra church relationships	Building a "respectable local program
Relationship with the world: [community]	Sees it as an ideological threat, avoids contact except to evangelize [monologue]	Seeks to relate to, understand, accept, and communicate with the world [dialogue]	Ignores: sees the world as an 'unpleasant' influence capable of diminishing the church's quality.
