

**The Disappearing Moral Curriculum**

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It shall be the duty of Trustees, Directors and Teachers of the College to impress upon the minds of the students, the principles of morality and justice and a sacred regard for truth; love of their country; humanity and universal benevolence; sobriety, frugality, chastity, moderation and temperance, and all other virtues that are ornaments of human society.  
**Charter of the Main Agricultural College, 1965.** [p.1].

When Main Agricultural College became the University of Main in 1897 students had to attend daily morning prayers in chapel; absence from 15 percent led to 'admonition' by the president, and if the behavior did not improve, to 'censure' by the faculty. Today no public university could require daily prayer, and what ever has happened to sobriety, frugality and chastity as educational aims?
